The \$1,000 Kate Mullany Courageous Young Worker Award honors young women who have stood up for workers' rights and organized their workplaces in the face of overwhelming opposition. The award is named for Kate Mullany, an inspiring young laundry worker who, more than 150 years ago, organized one of the first women's unions when she was just 19 years old.
